

RESOLUTION NO. 16 - 7

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER OR IN HIS ABSENCE THE ASSISTANT CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER TO EXECUTE DOCUMENTS ON BEHALF OF THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

WHEREAS, Section CG 2-106 of the County Government Article of the Code of Public Local Laws of Worcester County, Maryland provides that one of the duties of the President of the Board of County Commissioners (the Board) shall be to sign official documents on behalf of the Board; and

WHEREAS, Section CG 2-107 of the County Government Article of the Code of Public Local Laws of Worcester County, Maryland provides that the Board may, by resolution, authorize and empower the Chief Administrative Officer to execute documents other than deeds, bonds, resolutions, bills and laws, on behalf of the County, which shall be binding as though executed by the President of the Board of County Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, the Board has previously authorized the Chief Administrative Officer, or in his absence the Assistant Chief Administrative Officer, by resolution, to approve the acceptance of sanitary facilities (Resolution No. 02-6 adopted on March 5, 2002), acceptance, release or reduction of certain bonds (Resolution No. 96-7 adopted on February 13, 1996), and acceptance of Perpetual Protective Agreements (Resolution No. 96-31 adopted on October 8, 1996); and


WHEREAS, the County Commissioners of Worcester County, Maryland, "Commissioners" have determined that it would be appropriate to grant the authority to execute all documents other than deeds, bonds, resolutions, bills and laws in accordance with the provisions of Section CG 2-107 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Worcester County, Maryland to the Chief Administrative Officer, or in his absence the Assistant Chief Administrative Officer, upon the favorable recommendation of the Worcester County Attorney, and subject to prior conceptual approval during a regular meeting of the Commissioners.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Commissioners of Worcester County, Maryland that in accordance with the provisions of Section CG 2-107 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Worcester County, Maryland, the Chief Administrative Officer, or in his absence the Assistant Chief Administrative Officer, is hereby authorized to execute all documents other than deeds, bonds, resolutions, bills and laws, on behalf of the County Commissioners of Worcester County, Maryland, upon the favorable recommendation of the Worcester County Attorney, and subject to prior conceptual approval during a regular meeting of the County Commissioners of Worcester County, Maryland.


AND, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall take effect upon its passage.
