

RESOLUTION NO. 21-26

**Resolution Adopting the Worcester County
Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan – FY 2023 to FY 2027**

Recitals:

- A. The County Commissioners of Worcester County, Maryland have determined that certain Capital Projects should be constructed from July 1, 2022 to June 30, 2027 to promote the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Worcester County and to provide adequate public facilities for the citizens of Worcester County; and
- B. The Worcester County Commissioners held a public hearing on December 7, 2021 to receive public comment on the Capital Projects proposed for construction in the Worcester County Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan–FY 2023 to FY 2027 (“Plan”).

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved by the County Commissioners of Worcester County, Maryland that the attached Worcester County Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan – FY 2023 to FY 2027 is adopted.

And Be It Further Resolved by the County Commissioners of Worcester County, Maryland that funding for the projects identified in the Plan may be provided from annual tax levies, issuance of public debt, use of reserve funds, or other sources as the County Commissioners may determine.


