

RESOLUTION NO. 22- 1
RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING SALARY AND ALLOWANCES FOR
JUDGES OF THE ORPHANS' COURT FOR WORCESTER COUNTY
FOR THE 2022-2026 TERM

Recitals

- A. Md. Code Estates & Trusts Art. § 2-108 provides that the County Commissioners of Worcester County determine the compensation for Judges of the Orphans' Court for Worcester County;
- B. The salaries of elected officials may not be changed during their term in office and must be established for the term before the commencement of the term;
- C. 2022 is an election year for local elected officials and the terms of the elected officials shall commence after November 2022.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Commissioners of Worcester County, Maryland that the Judges of the Orphans' Court shall receive such compensation and allowances for the term of office commencing after the election of November 2022 as indicated below:

- 1. The salary of the Judges of the Orphans' Court shall be \$9,500 per year. They shall also receive a traveling expense allowance of \$1,600 each per year.
- 2. The Judges of the Orphans' Court may also be entitled to receive an allowance of reimbursement for such other specific extraordinary expenses incurred in the course of their official duties as may have been specifically authorized and approved by the County Commissioners.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall take effect upon the commencement of the 2022-2026 term.


